

CATS - Code of Conduct

CATS members are expected to treat one another positively at all times, both in person and online and on social media platforms. It is important to remain polite, respectful and supportive. Members are reminded that their personal conduct can impact on CATS by association. Should criticism be necessary, it should always be constructive and not personal.

Keep the working environment safe and tidy for everybody else.

- Put all litter in the bins provided and clear up any spills immediately.
- Don't leave props, costume items, etc. anywhere other than the designated places.
- Take care bringing hot drinks into the rehearsal space whilst movement is taking place.
- Wash up any cups and utensils you use.

During rehearsals and productions it is important that full attention is given to the activity taking place. This is essential for everybody's health and safety and to ensure effective use of everyone's time.

- Ensure you attend all rehearsals promptly and follow any absence procedures should you be unable to attend.
- Avoid excessive use of mobile devices during rehearsals, especially when your participation is required.
- Avoid eating and drinking during rehearsals, except during breaks.
- Ensure you sign in and sign out on the fire register.

When children are present at CATS activities it is essential that the conduct and language of older members is appropriate. It is also important not to take any photographs or video of children under the age of 16. Rehearsal material may be recorded by committee members only.

Failure to comply to this code of conduct may jeopardise your position in a production or the society.
